## **Duties**

Help faculty in setting up and running labs, run recitation sessions, mentor students, maintain office hours, etc., as determined by the faculty adviser.

## **Requirements**

- Senior standing – anyone who is currently in a Capstone project or has finished one and has two terms left before graduating
- Minimum GPA: 3.25 – both cumulative and major
- Application submittal and two letters of recommendation
